Founder and Chief Editor of scientific journal Research on Entrepreneurship in Modern Economics (REME). Member of scientific board of scientific journals from Poland and Ukraine. Organizer and co-organizer of international ENTIME (Entrepreneurship in Modern Economy) conference, hosted by the faculty regularly since 2008.

Member of European Council for Small Business, Country Vice president for 2018–2019 and 2020–2022 terms. From 2019, Member of Business Council for the President of the Republic of Poland.

Co-founder of the society Education for Entrepreneurship, its board member for three terms. Co-founder of Foundation for the Development of Economic Thought at the Faculty, and a leader of its scientific board.

The main fields of scientific interest are entrepreneurship, its modes, and methods. Author of more than 100 publications (including six books) as well as papers regarding growth of small firms, tax morality and unproductive entrepreneurship. However, the favourite subject, a kind of scientific hobby, is women entrepreneurship. Supervisor of three PhD theses, as well as two more that are in progress.

From 2006, head of the Entrepreneurship team, within the Economics and Enterprise Management Department. Co-founder of the Department of Entrepreneurship and Economic Law, and its head from 2013 to 2020.

Dean of the Faculty of Management and Economics for two terms (2012–2020).
